GCSE Results Day Arrangements

As you may be aware, GCSE results will be published on **Thursday 20th August**.

In order for students to collect their results, the academy will be open **between 9am and 10.30am**. There is no requirement for students to wear school uniform.

We strongly recommend that students attend in person however they may nominate somebody else to collect their results on their behalf, but this must be done before Results Day with a letter brought to school by the student who is unable to attend. The deadline to bring this letter into school is **Monday 29th June**.

The signed letter from the student should name the person collecting results along with their name as the person who is having their results collected. It should also be signed. For example, 'I, Joe Bloggs, give permission for my mother, Jill Bloggs, to collect my GCSE results on my behalf, signed, J. Bloggs'. Additionally, authorised persons collecting results must provide a form of identification displaying their full name when they come to collect results.

As part of the day, we will have guidance available to assist students with their next steps. Any provision to re-mark exam papers must also be sorted on the day in person. Due to the rigorous marking procedures that exam boards have, our policy is only to send off scripts that are one mark away from the next grade boundary and this requires the written consent of the students. This means that **once Results Day is over, we will not send off any more scripts off for a re-marking**.

While students will receive their results on **Thursday 20th August**, their actual exam certificates will be sent to the academy at a later date and are expected to arrive around Easter time. Once the certificates arrive, we will contact students individually to inform them of their availability for collection at the academy.

In the event that any results remain uncollected, they will be securely held at the academy. To collect any uncollected results, a pre-booked appointment will be necessary, and the earliest collection date will be once the school has reopened to all students in September. **We will not share screenshots of results or send them via post**. Please be aware that the same necessary checks mentioned in this letter, including the authorised person's identification, will still apply during the pre-booked appointment.
